15-18 Yrs. Old - \$ 20.00 per entry/ \$ 45.00- Non- Member (Must register with a club)

- **Receipts will be given for payment.**
- **All funds, and records will be collected, and held by Tournament Director, and become the property of (Jr. LA B.A.S.S. NATION).**
- **Winner's registration information and Copy of Birth Certificate; will be forwarded to LA B.A.S.S. NATION State President for the next level tournament.**

CLUB'S PRE REGISTRATION MUST SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING:

- **Current 2012 or 2013 Club Roster**
- **If (Entry Fee, Birth Certificate, and registration paperwork) collected by the Jr. club; then on Friday's registration, Jr. club can turn in all signed registrations, Birth Certificates, and One(1) check made: PAYABLE TO (JR. LA B.A.S.S. NATION); with a copy of Club Roster indicating payment received (PER ENTRY)**
- **One Boat and Boat Captain per Two(2) contestants required.**

Boat numbers will be given out after safety check on Friday.

(Please provide enough boats, and captains for contestants)

Clubs coming from around the state – must provide a boat, and a boat Captain per Two(2) contestants.

- **If you can; Please bring extra boats and captains; they will be assigned Jr.s without boats.**

Please make every effort to help with this matter!!!

****Tournament Director will try to place every contestant in a boat –**

- **Entry Fees, Signed Registration's, and Birth Certificates must be turned in on Friday, April 19, 2013- incomplete forms will be rejected. (Contestant will not be able to fish)**
- **Should a contestant traveling from out of town – require a late registration –they must notify Tournament Director ASAP, have a representative at the meeting on Friday, and provide the name of the boat Captain.**
- **ALL REGISTRATIONS WILL BE APPROVED BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR ONLY.**

B.A.S.S. TOURNAMENT RULES APPLY

All State/ Federal/ Local Safety and Gaming laws apply

Minimum 14" fish rule applies (Catch & Release) Dead fish -Penalty 1/4lb (0.25 .lb) per fish

7-10 Yrs. Old- * Can't Advance

11-14 Yrs. Old - Winner advances to Central Divisional Championship

15-18 Yrs. Old - Winner advances to Central Divisional Championship

****Note:

NO CASH PRIZES, OR CASH CONTRIBUTIONS WILL BE GIVEN OUT AT THIS TOURNAMENT.

B.A.S.S. / LA B.A.S.S. NATION -DOES NOT PROVIDE TRAVEL, LOST WAGES, FOOD EXPENSE TO, AND FROM CENTRAL DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP- OR JR. BASSMASTERS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

WINNERS RESPONSIBLE FOR EXPENSES & TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS TO AND FROM EVENTS.

LA B.A.S.S. NATION WILL PROVIDE One(1) HOTEL ROOM FOR WINNER, AND THEIR FAMILY. (CENTRAL DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP- OR JR. BASSMASTERS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.)

Please remember; should the State Champion of his or her age group; decline to attend the Central Divisional Championship- the 2nd place winner goes in his or her place. If 2nd place winner declines; 3rd place winner goes. If all decline; then the next highest weight weighed-in; for that age group will be asked and so on!

***Note: Tournament Fees collected:**

Tournament Director will reimburse upon a receipt or invoice presented; tournament expenses covered by the state expenses rules.

Hotel and travel expense reimbursement for National, State, or Club Sponsors guest / dignitaries, or owners; will be handled on a one to one basis. Check with tournament director before invitation/ arraignments are made.

Clubs are asked to disburse equally all travel expense contributions to both WINNERS OR PARTICIPANTS.

Winners are responsible to secure any and all donations, and or contributions in their club's area.
